Reports and Class Placements

Staff are spending a considerable amount of time on class structures for 2018 and student placement in classes.

We have considered many factors in this process including:

- The educational needs of the students
- The projected number of students in each year level
- The ratio of boys to girls
- Socially balance groups from existing year level classes, so new friendships can be formed.
- Academic performance judgements over time
- Work habits
- Behaviour
- Social network
- Social maturity
- Special needs

Any change after the 14th Dec will trigger a chain reaction of other changes so we will **NOT** be moving students.

It is acknowledged by all that friendships are important. However to ensure balanced classes as outlined above, friendship groups are not a primary determining factor in class placement processes. Learning to connect with new students is an important life skill.

Students will visit next years class on the Thursday before school breaks up (14/12/17). It is on this same day that reports and class placement slips will go home.

I'm sure you will speak with your child on Thursday evening about the benefits of being brave and getting to make new friends in 2018.



Ensure you stay for the Year 7 Big Finale!


Please be respectful of the children by supporting them and remaining quiet during class items and announcements. Teachers and students have put a lot of time and effort into their performances tonight.

Our school will appear in 'Nearby Locations' if you're within 10kms of the school, or search for our school by name.


Step 4 Register your children




