

Step 2> Add Login details as provided by teacher, as shown below, and your student's bookshelf will open.





Step 3> See notes for **Parents** to access resources to support your child's reading at home, and your student bookshelf.







Step 4> Click on any title to open. **Audio** is in left bottom corner and **page turning** on the right. Notes for parents are on inside back and front covers.







Step 5> Look for embedded information in text and click for information sheet or short video.
